"Amalgams and Linearization"**

Andrews Amalgams (e.g., "I've made I don't know how many false claims") are one of a species of cases in which apparently two sentences combine into one string. I will sketch a syntax of Andrews Amalgams that makes sense of some of its key properties and then propose a linearization procedure that captures how that syntax projects onto the right strings.
